Recognition and Commendation

Director **Raymond Laflamme** (Institute of Quantum Computing) and Professor **Robert Hecky** (Biology) are among the 72 new fellows of the Royal Society of Canada. Laflamme, who is also a Professor of Physics, has solved both practical and theoretical problems of fundamental importance to quantum information processing, says the RSC's citation. It adds that he has been a leader in bringing Canada to international prominence in the field. "He elucidated theoretical approaches to quantum error correction, which set the benchmark in this field, and gave the first experimental demonstrations of these techniques." Hecky, who recently moved to the University of Minnesota at Duluth, but also holds a part-time Research Professor position at UW) is world-renowned for his work on African great lakes and northern reservoirs, says the citation. For more than 30 years he has led international groups investigating the hydrology, chemistry, biology and paleo-ecology of those ecosystems. "His research has led to the development of an excellent research laboratory in Uganda and to the understanding of how climate, land-use and air quality have affected the great lakes of east Africa." This year's new fellows will be inducted at a ceremony to be held November 15 in Ottawa. The two new appointees make a total of 65 Waterloo faculty who have been named over the years to Canada's highest academic honour.

Professor **Alan Morgan** (Earth Sciences) is the 2008 winner of the McNeil Medal from the Royal Society of Canada, honouring "outstanding ability to promote and communicate science to students and the public within Canada." Says a citation from the RSC: "Dr. Morgan is a gifted and committed communicator of science who achieved national and international prominence with his production of the highly acclaimed documentary film concerning the volcanic eruption of Eldfell in 1973. He is a superb and inspiring lecturer, remains prominent in the print media as an editor and author and is a leader in the educational use of electronic formats."

Professor **Janusz Pawliszyn** (Chemistry) is the 2008 winner of the \$100,000 EnCana Principal Award from the Ernest C. Manning Awards Foundation. The award recognizes Canadian innovators who, like Pawliszyn, have made a significant impact in the world outside the lab. His invention of solid-phase microextraction (SPME) has transformed chemical testing. "SPME has revolutionized the way that samples are collected and extracted," says Bruce Fenwick, Executive Director of the Foundation. "Before the commercial development of SPME, many chemical tests were time-consuming and required the use of hazardous organic solvents. But with SPME, sample collection and extraction is simple, safe and can be done on site." This is the fourth time in 10 years that a Waterloo nominee will receive one of Canada's most prestigious innovation prizes. Pawliszyn joins Manning Award winners En-hui Yang (2007), Mike Lazaridis and Gary Mousseau (2002) and Roman Baldur (1999). Pawliszyn holds the National Sciences and Engineering Research Council (NSERC) Industrial Research Chair and Canada Research Chair in New Analytical Methods and Technologies.

A group of Canadian engineering students (comprising recent Waterloo graduates **Jeff Kao**, **Robert Lam**, **Taneem Talukdar**) has won a \$275,000 US prize from internet search giant Google Inc. for a mobile phone application that lets users calculate and adjust their travel carbon footprint. The group of five students was among ten groups named winners of the top prize of Google's Android Developer Challenge, which asked developers to come up with useful applications using Google's software platform. Their program, Ecorio, gives users the ability to reduce their environmental footprint with tools that provide transit options for trips, allows them to invest in carbon reduction projects and share their tips with other users. Other applications that won top awards from Google included programs that help users find taxi cabs, scan product barcodes and personalize photos. Google released Android, a free downloadable software development kit for mobile phones, in November 2007, with the goal of creating a common platform that would make it easier for developers to create programs and for consumers to surf the web on cellphones. It launched the contest at the same time, promising to give more than \$10 million in prizes.

To date, UW has awarded this distinction to eleven individuals: Garry Rempel, Mary Thompson and Mark Zanna in 2004; Terry McMahon, Cam Stewart and Robert Jan van Pelt in 2005; Phelim Boyle and Ian Munro in 2006; Ken Davidson, Keith Hipel and Jake Sivak in 2007; Roy Cameron and Flora Ng in 2008.

This memo is to remind you of the process [described below] which was established in 2003 when Senate approved the introduction of the 'University Professor' designation. You should also be aware that the University Tenure and Promotion Committee [i.e. the selection committee] decided when it considered the first round of nominations that the dossiers of unsuccessful nominees would remain in the pool for two additional years, with the understanding that the appropriate Dean would provide updated information each year.

Please ensure that nomination material is in my hands before Christmas.

UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR

The University of Waterloo owes much of its reputation and stature to the quality of its eminent professors. UW recognizes exceptional scholarly achievement and international pre-eminence through the designation 'University Professor'. Once appointed, a faculty member retains the designation for life.

Not counting retirees, it is anticipated there will be 14 University Professorships at steady state, with at most two appointments each year. Such appointments are reported to Senate and to the Board of Governors in March and April respectively, and are recognized at Convocation.

Selection Process

1. Annually, nominations will be sought from Deans, Directors and Chairs, as well as from the University community generally. A nominee shall have demonstrated exceptional scholarly achievement and international pre-eminence in a particular field or fields of knowledge. The individual who nominates a colleague is responsible for gathering the documentation and submitting it to the Vice-President, Academic & Provost. The University Tenure and Promotion Committee will act as the selection committee; its decisions are final.
2. A nomination must be supported by at least six signatures from at least two UW departments and must be accompanied by a curriculum vitae and a short, non-technical description of the nominee's contributions. A nomination must also be accompanied by letters from the nominee's Dean, and from at least two and no more than five scholars of international standing in the nominee's field from outside the University. The letter of nomination should explain why these particular scholars were chosen as referees. The referees should be asked to comment on the impact and specific nature of the nominee's most influential contributions, addressing their responses directly to the Vice-President, Academic & Provost.
